

Fig. S1. Study flow chart. NF1: neurofibromatosis type 1.

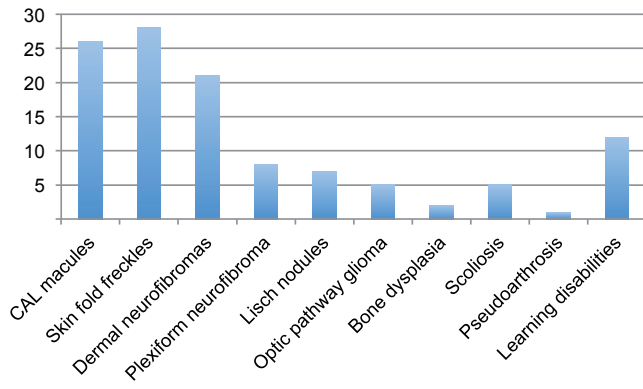


Fig. S2. Clinical characteristics (n). CAL: café-au-lait.
