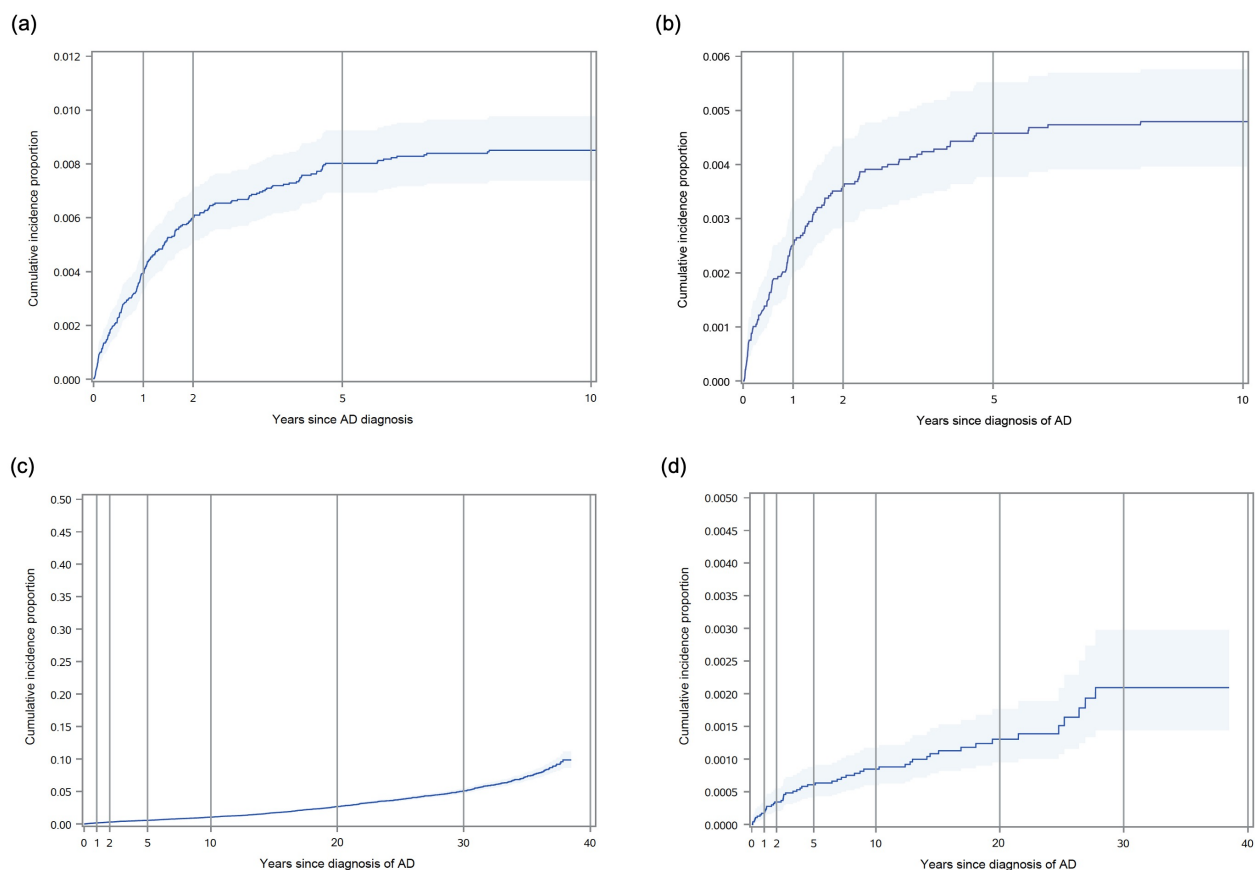
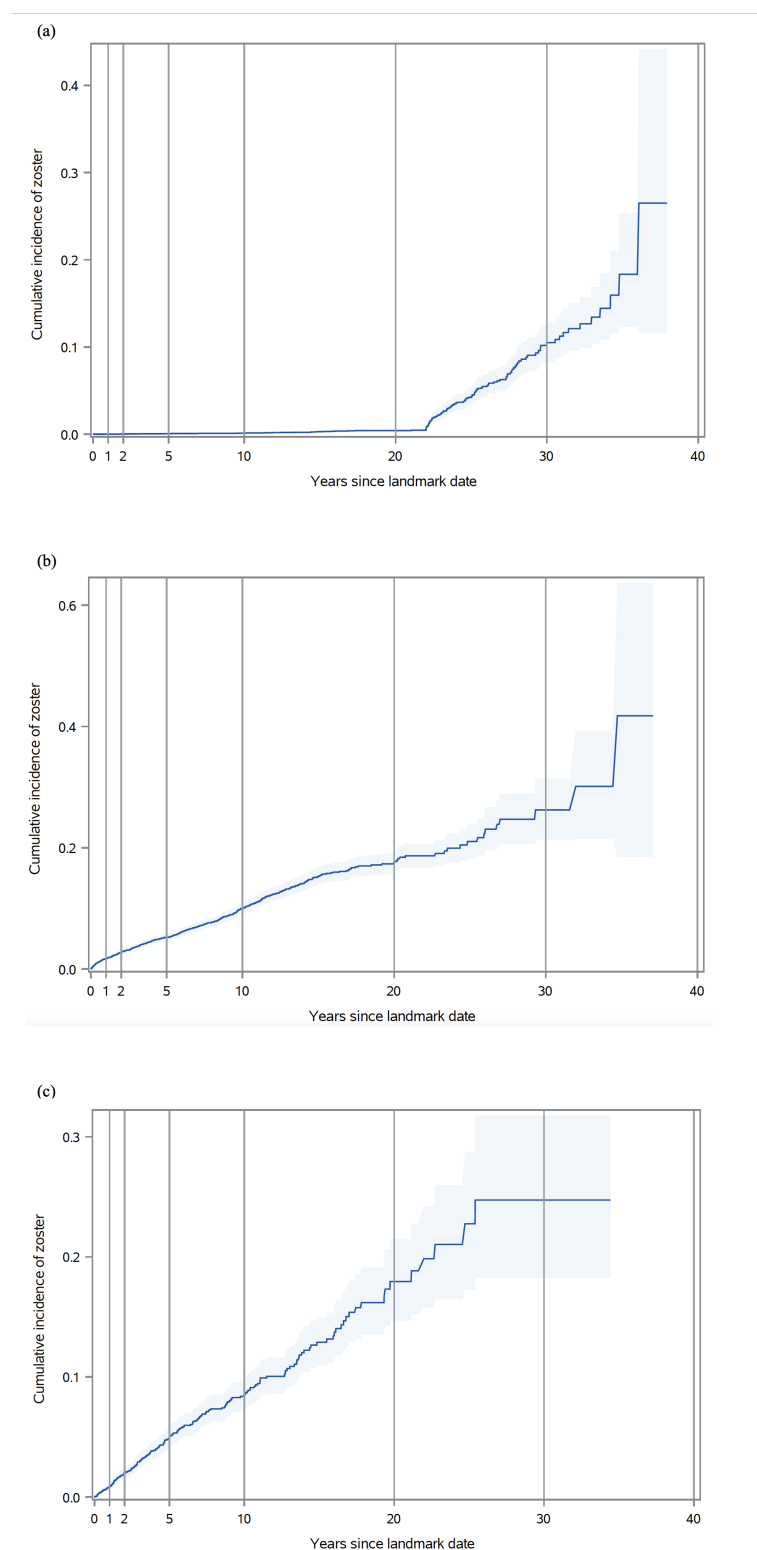


Figure S1. Cumulative incidence proportion with 95% confidence interval of (a) any varicella hospital diagnosis, (b) hospitalization with varicella, (c) any zoster diagnosis, and (d) hospitalization with zoster in people with hospital-diagnosed atopic dermatitis (AD)



Note the difference in scale for the axes. Varicella analyses were restricted to patients aged below 6 years at the time of first AD diagnosis because of few events in older age groups.
