Receiver operating characteristics (ROC curves) of Psoriasis Area and Severity Index (PASI) to predict concomitant cardiovascular risk C-reactive protein (CRP) and neutrophil-to-lymphocyte ratio (NLR) category values. ROC curves of PASI to predict CRP values of equal or more than 3 mg/l (*black line*) and NLR values of equal or more than 2.15 (*grey line*), which were shown to indicate a higher cardiovascular risk. Both curves are shallow with an area under the curve (AUC) of 0.643 for CRP and 0.592 for NLR.
