Tumour

- T1: Solitary involvement of skin
- T1a: Solitary lesion < 5 cm in diameter
- T1b: Solitary lesion > 5 cm in diameter
- T2: Regional involvement of skin: multiple lesions limited to one body region or two contiguous body regions
- T2a: All-disease-encompassing in <15-cm diameter circular area
- T2b: All-disease-encompassing in > 15-cm and < 30-cm diameter circular area
- T2c: All-disease-encompassing in > 30-cm diameter circular area
- T3: Generalized involvement of skin
- T3a: Multiple lesions involving two non-contiguous body regions
- T3b: Multiple lesion involving ≥ three body regions

Node

- N0: No clinical or pathologic involvement of lymph node
- N1: Involvement of one peripheral lymph node region that drains an area of current or prior skin involvement
- N2: Involvement of ≥2 peripheral lymph node regions or involvement of any lymph node region that does not drain an area of current or prior skin involvement
- N3: Involvement of central lymph nodes

Metastases

- M0: No evidence of extracutaneous non-lymph node disease
- M1: Extracutaneous non-lymph node diesease present
