

Table SI. Proposed tumour, lymph node, metastasis classification of cutaneous lymphoma other than mycosis fungoides/Sezary syndrome by the European Organization of Research and Treatment of Cancer/International Society for Cutaneous Lymphomas: classification and description

Tumour

T1: Solitary involvement of skin

T1a: Solitary lesion <5 cm in diameter

T1b: Solitary lesion >5 cm in diameter

T2: Regional involvement of skin: multiple lesions limited to one body region or two contiguous body regions

T2a: All-disease-encompassing in <15-cm diameter circular area

T2b: All-disease-encompassing in >15-cm and <30-cm diameter circular area

T2c: All-disease-encompassing in >30-cm diameter circular area

T3: Generalized involvement of skin

T3a: Multiple lesions involving two non-contiguous body regions

T3b: Multiple lesion involving \geq three body regions

Node

N0: No clinical or pathologic involvement of lymph node

N1: Involvement of one peripheral lymph node region that drains an area of current or prior skin involvement

N2: Involvement of \geq 2 peripheral lymph node regions or involvement of any lymph node region that does not drain an area of current or prior skin involvement

N3: Involvement of central lymph nodes

Metastases

M0: No evidence of extracutaneous non-lymph node disease

M1: Extracutaneous non-lymph node disease present
