

## EDITORIAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE CHANGES

According to the regulations for ACTA ODONTOLOGICA SCANDINAVICA, the position as Editor shall periodically alternate between the four Scandinavian countries. Throughout its history, i.e. starting in 1939, editors from Sweden (professor dr. Y. Hildebrand, dr. E. Hellner, professor dr. G. Nyquist), Denmark (professor dr. P. O. Pedersen) and Finland (professor dr. A. Scheinin) have substantially contributed to the success of the Journal.

From January 1, 1977 professor dr. Ivar A. Mjør, Norway, will act as editor of the ACTA ODONTOLOGICA SCANDINAVICA. This change of editor will not involve alterations in the policy of the Journal, nor in its format, lay-out or frequency of publication. All manuscripts will be reviewed by experts/referees prior to editorial decision. Emphasis will still be placed on a presentation of dental research in Scandinavia to the international scientific community.

Accompanying the change of editor, a major change in the administration of ACTA ODONTOLOGICA SCANDINAVICA will also take place. Until about 2 years ago the

Swedish Dental Society played an important role in the administration of the Journal. After a temporary movement of these duties to Finland, they are now instigated to Norway. The new address for editorial and administrative matters (excluding subscription) will be: *Den norske tannlægeforening, (The Norwegian Dental Association), Kronprinsensgate 9, Oslo 2, Norway*. The printing of the Journal will be handled by Fabritius & Sønner in collaboration with Ingeniørforlaget  $\frac{A}{S}$  in Oslo, and the subscription and distribution by Fellesekspedisjonen A.S (address: Box 242, Sentrum, Oslo 1, Norway). The Norwegian Dental Association will assist in the administrative tasks of the Journal and Bente Try at the Association will act as assistant editor. The six issues of ACTA ODONTOLOGICA SCANDINAVICA per year will be published bimonthly starting February 1977.
