

## British Council Medical Courses

### *Oral and Maxillo-Facial Surgery 13–25 June in Glasgow*

The aim of this Glasgow-based course is to review modern methods of diagnosis and treatment of major deformities, and traumatic and oncological conditions of the head and neck. Temporo-mandibular joint disease, aspects of infection and research problems will also be considered. Time will be set aside for discussion so that participants may share their experiences in the appropriate session. Mr K F Moos, MB, BS, FDS, RCS, Consultant Oral Surgeon, Plastic and Maxillo-Facial Unit, Canniesburn Hospital, Glasgow will be the Director of Studies. Visits to the Plastic and Maxillo-Facial Unit and other local Departments will be arranged if requested.

The course is open to senior practising Oral and Maxillo-Facial surgeons and others involved in the speciality.
