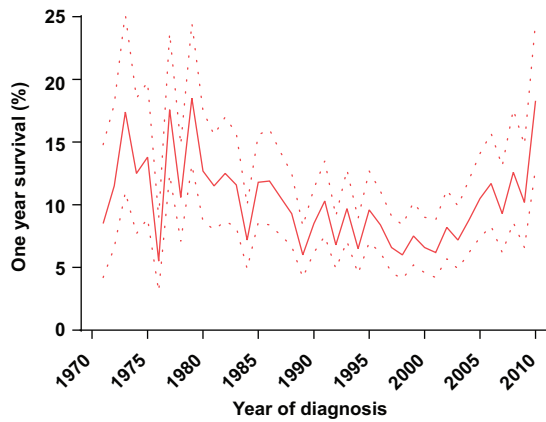
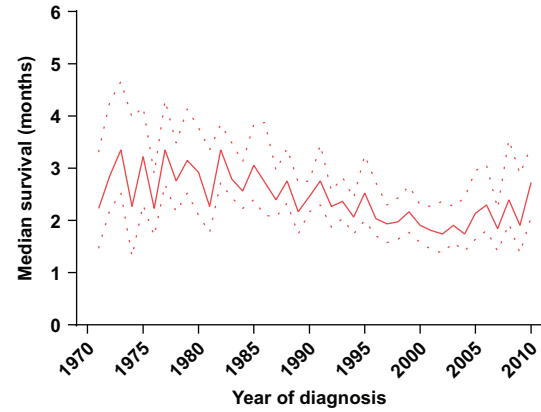

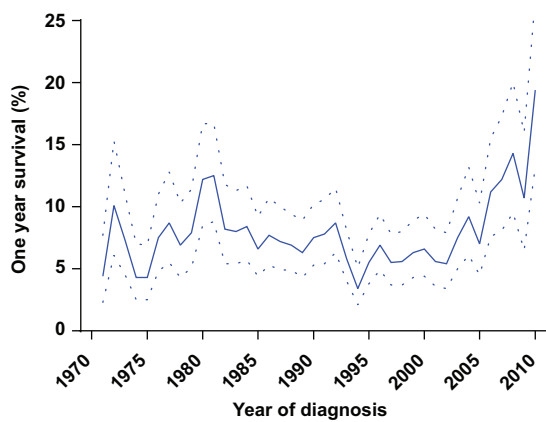
(a) One-year survival of cancer of unknown primary (females)



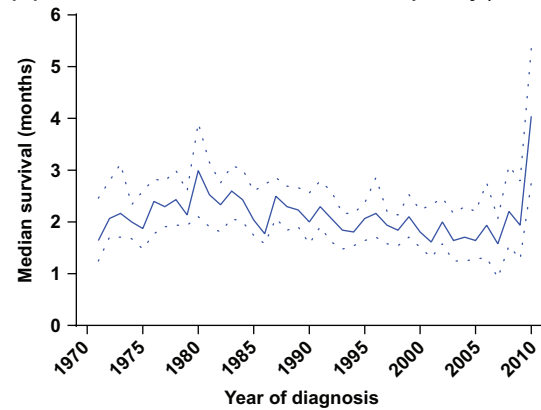
(a) Median survival of cancer of unknown primary (females)

Supplementary Figure 1. The one-year survival of CUP has increased over the latest 10 years, now approaching 20% for both females (a) and males (b). Lower and upper 95% confidence intervals are shown as dotted lines.

Supplementary Figure 2. Median survival of CUP has been low and stable for both females (a) and males (b) over the 40 year period, but an upward shift might now be seen. Lower and upper 95% confidence intervals are shown as dotted lines.
