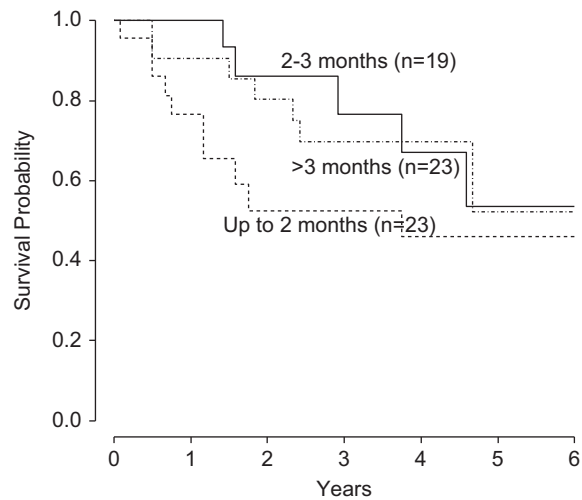

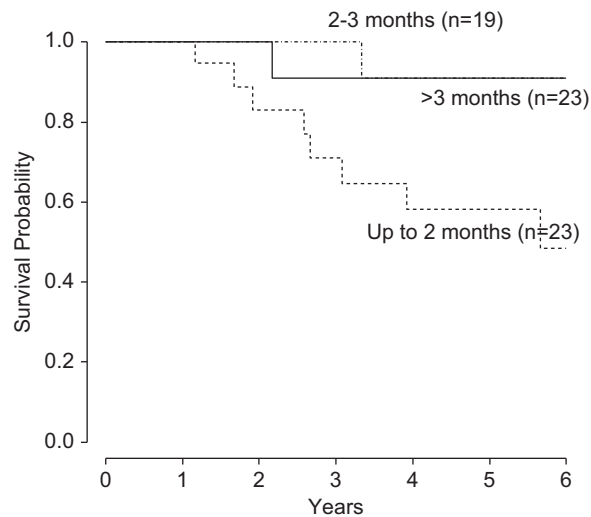
**Disease Free Survival (DFS)**

Log-rank p-value: 0.03  
(Up to 2 months vs. > 2 months)  
Adjusted HR: 0.6, 95%CI [0.2-1.8]  
Adjusted for pN, ER, neoadjuvant chemotherapy



**Overall Survival (OS)**

Log-rank p-value: <0.01  
(Up to 2 months vs. > 2 months)  
Adjusted HR: 1.6, 95%CI [0.4-7.4]  
Adjusted for pN and ER
